Murrow Academic Equipment Center Loaner Agreement

I am a current WSU student participating in the 2025 Rural Reporting Plunge travel event . I understand I will be using expensive equipment provided by the Murrow Academic Equipment Center (hereafter “Equipment Room”) and will handle the Equipment Room property (audio/video equipment and its accessories [e.g. lens covers, SD cards, batteries, windscreens, etc.]) with the utmost care while in my possession.

Fees/grade impacts

- It is a student conduct issue (WAC 504-25-070) if the Equipment Room property is damaged or lost in my possession.

I agree to

- Pay for the repair/replacement of equipment equal to the cost of the damage or property cost.

Unreasonable Wear and Tear includes, but is not limited to

- Lost equipment, broken tripod brackets, cracked lenses/screens, torn or broken straps, non-functioning buttons, scratched lenses/screens, heat/cold damage from being left in vehicles.

Normal Wear and Tear includes

- Torn windscreens, dirty lenses, worn paint, broken zipper pull tabs, and battery drainage.

Other Legal Terms

- Title: Equipment is WSU property.
- Usage Charges: Student is responsible for any usage charges incurred.
- Data: WSU is not responsible for lost SD card data.
- Indemnification/Hold Harmless: Student agrees to hold WSU harmless from all related claims or losses.
- Governing Law: Washington State law applies; venue is Whitman County.
- No Warranties: Equipment is provided without warranties.
- Termination: WSU may terminate this Agreement at any time with notice.
